The George D. Heaton Award recognizes those who exemplify excellent human relations skills in their positions of leadership. The recipient can be a foreman, supervisor, manager, chief executive or anyone in a staff position who presents or promotes the practice of excellent human relations. Anyone who participated in the Blue Ridge Conference on Leadership can submit nominations for this award. George Dewitt Heaton II first spoke at the Blue Ridge Conference on Leadership in 1939 when he was 20 years old. He came back each of the next 55 years, becoming an integral part of the conference. A statue stands in his honor on the grounds of the YMCA Blue Ridge Assembly and a building is named in his honor.
